Attending various Charleston Baptist Church meetings and events, including weekly team meetings and weekend services.

Managing the upkeep and availability of the CB Students ministry areas, equipment, supplies, and records.

Partnering with the CB Kids infant-5th grade and CB Adult Ministry teams to ensure the cohesive implementation of a ministry philosophy from birth to college graduation, with a practical focus on student leadership roles and serving opportunities in the CB Kids and CB Adults areas.
