PASTORS PERSPECTIVE: LEE CHINNIS

What can be said about truth vs. lies? Read Genesis 2:4-3:24.

Since the beginning of time, we humans have dealt with the questions: What is true? What is a lie? There are different ways to determine truth vs. lies. Let's look at Adam and Eve, as an example.
