PASTORS PERSPECTIVE: TOMMY HARLEY



During my lifetime, I have seen and experienced many changes. Some of these are personal, while others are more universal. Communication, technology, transportation, sports, education, and yes, in some regards, even church has changed. However, the one constant is God. We are reminded of this in the following verses: Malachi 3:6 says, "For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed," and Hebrews 13:8 tells us, "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." If God does not change, then his characteristics do not change. We find the first detailed description of God's character in Exodus 34:6-7 which says, "The Lord passed before him and proclaimed, 'The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, but who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children and the children's children, to the third and the fourth generation." Notice steadfast love appears in both verses 6 and 7. Personally, I struggle to comprehend God's steadfast love for me, but this characteristic continues to appear in my devotions, my daily Bible reading, discussions with others and even in sermons from Psalm 119. I am going to use lyrics from two of my favorite songs to help explain my thoughts. Lauren Daigle's "Love Like This" puts it this way, "What have I done to deserve love like this? I cannot earn what you so freely give." Although I can't understand God's steadfast love for me, I KNOW He loves me. This is simply said in my favorite song which was played at our wedding, "Jesus loves me this I know for the Bible tells me so". A well-known passage from the Old Testament says, "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness" (Lamentations 3:22-23).


