Did you notice the 3 "I am" statements?

- -I am under obligation. This doesn't mean that we are trying to pay God back for all the good things He has done for us. However, it does mean, that God's grace is so valuable to me that I want everyone to have it.
- -I am eager to preach the gospel. With all my heart, soul, and strength, I am passionate about making Jesus known to the people in my life. Wow! After 30+ years of Paul being saved, he is just as passionate about the gospel now as he was then.
- -I am not ashamed of the gospel. This means we are not losing confidence in the power of the gospel. The only thing that can save and transform people is the gospel.

By God's grace this year, let us press into the joy and responsibility of these 3 "I am" statements. We are trusting in the sufficiency and power of the gospel for our lives and the lives of others!
